World Bid Declaration

ACP is proud to award 13 Bids (5 Paid Bids and 11 At-Large) to **The Cheerleading Worlds** at the 2019 Midwest All Star National Championship.

5 PAID BIDS

ACP will reserve **1** Paid Bid to a Senior Coed Team and will reserve **1** Paid Bid to a Senior All Girl Team. ACP will reserve **1** Paid Bid to an International Open/Open Coed/Senior Open/Senior Open Coed Team **if score permits**. The remaining Full Paid Bids will be awarded to the highest scoring Senior/Senior Coed Teams combined. If any of these teams have a previously earned PAID bid from another event producer, ACP will award the bid(s) to the next highest scoring eligible team(s). ACP reserves the right to award an originally designated International Open/Open Coed/Senior Open/Senior Open Coed Paid Bid to a Senior/Senior Coed Team or vice versa.

10 AT-LARGE BIDS

Once the PAID bids have been secured, ACP will award 10 AT-LARGE Bids to the next 10-overall highest scores within all Senior/Senior Coed/Senior Open/Senior Open Coed Level 5 Divisions and/or International Open/Open Coed Teams combined. If any of these 8 teams have a previously earned AT-LARGE Bid from another event producer, ACP will move the AT-LARGE Bid to the next overall highest scoring eligible team(s).

1 International Non-Tumbling (Provisional) AT-LARGE BID

ACP will award 1 AT-LARGE Bid to the highest scoring International Open NT/International Open Co-Ed NT Level 5 Provisional Team. If any of these teams have previous earned AT-LARGE Bid from another event producer, ACP will move the AT-LARGE Bid to the next overall highest scoring eligible team. This Bid is only reserved for the International Non-Tumbling Level 5 Provisional Divisions; if there are no teams eligible for this Bid, the Bid will NOT be passed to a Senior or Open Team.

To be eligible for a World Bid, teams MUST have a verified USASF Event Roster & the number of active athletes on the Roster must match the registered/competing number of athletes on the team.
